- This rebate is not retroactive.
- Qualifying washer purchased between Jan 1-Nov 30 of calendar year must be postmarked on or before Dec 31 of calendar year or rebate will be denied.
- Qualifying washer purchased between Dec 1-Dec 31 of calendar year must be postmarked on or before Jan 31 of following year or rebate will be denied.
- Qualifying washer purchased & installed must be new and for primary use in the CSU service territory.
- Installation address must have CSU residential electric, natural gas, and or water service or rebate will be denied.
- CSU account(s) for rebate participant must be current and non-delinquent (i.e. no past due balances) at the time the rebate application is processed or rebate will be denied. Should this be rectified within 30 days, please call 448-4800 to have your rebate application reviewed again.
- CSU customers who pay their utility bill through a homeowners association and would like to participate in the rebate program must visit [www.csu.org](http://www.csu.org) for special instructions.
- Landlords who participate in the rebate program for their rental property(ies) and who do not have an active account with CSU must complete and submit an IRS form W-9 along with all other required documentation.
- Rebates are issued as a credit applied to the CSU service account and take six to eight weeks to process.
- Incomplete applications, worksheets, qualifying documentation, and those lacking a copy of appropriate documentation will be denied.
- Installation site is subject to inspection by CSU staff.
- If a property for which a rebate has been issued is found upon inspection not to have the qualifying product, the amount rebated will be charged back to the CSU account which was originally credited.
- Qualifying purchases do not guarantee approval of a rebate. Rebates are offered on a first come, first served basis and subject to availability of funds.
- Rebates are limited to one (1) per product category per customer/property every three (3) years.
- CSU is not responsible for lost, late, damaged, illegible, misdirected or postage-due applications.
- CSU can choose to discontinue rebates at any time.
