How to get your CLOTHES WASHER or DISHWASHER rebate:

1. Purchase an ENERGY STAR qualified clothes washer or dishwasher.
2. Fill out this application and include:
 - **Your original receipt** citing the model number on the receipt for your new ENERGY STAR qualified dishwasher or clothes washer. The original receipt will be returned.
 - **Verification the appliance is an ENERGY STAR model.** Qualifying models are listed at www.energystar.gov. Use your original receipt as verification if it cites the brand and model number, or use other manufacturer documents included with your machine citing brand and specific model number.
 - A completed and signed **Affidavit of Lawful Presence** in the U.S. below and a copy of an **acceptable form of identification**. Samples are listed below.
 - A copy of your **current City of Longmont utility bill**. You must have an active City of Longmont electric or water utility account at the time of appliance purchase and rebate application. The application, utility bill, photo ID and Affidavit of Lawful Presence must all have the same name. The application and utility bill must both have the same address.
3. No later than 90 days from the date of purchase shown on your receipt, bring or mail all materials to:

How to get your ULTRA LOW-VOLUME or DUAL-FLUSH TOILET rebate:

1. Replace your old 3.5 gallon per flush toilet with a new qualified ULV or dual-flush toilet.
2. Fill out this application and include:
 - **A copy of the receipt** for your new toilet.
 - The completed and signed **Affidavit of Lawful Presence** in the U.S. and a copy of an acceptable form of identification.
 - A copy of your current City of Longmont utility bill. You must have an active City of Longmont water utility account at the time of appliance purchase and rebate application. The application, utility bill, **photo ID** and Affidavit of Lawful Presence must all have the same name; the application and utility bill must both have the same address.
3. Bring the required documents and your old 3.5-gallon-per-flush toilet, with tank and bowl separated, no later than 90 days from date of purchase, to City of Longmont Waste Diversion Center, 140 Martin Street in Longmont. Old toilet drop-off hours are Monday through Wednesday - 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM, Thursday through Saturday - 8:30 AM to 5:00 PM

Affidavit of Lawful Presence in the United States:

I further acknowledge that making a false, fictitious, or fraudulent statement or representation in this sworn affidavit is punishable under the criminal law of Colorado as perjury in the second degree under C.R.S. 18-8-503 and it shall constitute a separate criminal offense each time a public benefit is fraudulently received.
